

## **Medications to Avoid Before Procedures**

Any injection, including Botox®, dermal fillers and local anesthetics, can cause significant bruising if you are on blood thinners. Surgery can cause additional bruising, which will slow your healing and promote swelling.

Do NOT take any of the following for two weeks prior to your injection and/or surgery:

Aspirin and aspirin-containing medications (Tylenol is acceptable)

Nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs) include: Advil Ibuprofen Naproxin Mediprin Alleve Nuprin Bextra **MotrinVioxx** Celebrex Herbal supplements and vitamins that thin the blood: Airborne Red Clover Vitamin C (>40 IU) Echinacea Fish oil (especially

Omega 3 supplements) Flax Seed **Garlic supplements** Gingko Biloba

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## Vitamin E (>40 IU) Ginseng

If you are on a blood thinner: Please let Dr. Cockerham know if you are on a potent blood thinner like Coumadin (warfarin) or Plavix; a special medical clearance will be required to stop these medications three days prior to injection or surgery.
